1. INTRODUCTION

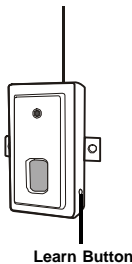
Congratulations on your purchase of the Skylink® Universal Visor Transmitter Model G6V. The Model G6V works with the Skylink Smart Button™. In this package, you will find a visor remote with 12V battery.



2. PROGRAM A VISOR REMOTE TO THE GTR SMART BUTTON™

Refer to the section in the Skylink® model GTR to install the Smart Button™ and follow the instructions below to program the transmitter.

1. With the GTR Smart Button™ connected on your existing wall button. The red light on the Smart Button™ should flash after plugging in the power. If the red light on the Smart Button™ is flashing slowly, that indicates it is in standby mode.
2. Press the learn button on the side of the GTR.
3. Once the learn button is pressed, the red LED will flash quickly. You may release the learn button.
4. Press the button on the transmitter you would like to program.
5. Once the transmitter is programmed, the red LED will flash slowly, in the same way as it flashes in standby mode.
6. You can now operate the garage door opener with this new remote control.



3. TROUBLE SHOOTING

Q: Door opener does not react after pressing the button on the transmitter?

- A:
- Ensure the button on the transmitter is pressed, the red light on the transmitter comes on. Otherwise, check if the battery is inserted properly.
 - Ensure the wires that are previous connected to the wall mounted door control are not loose.
 - Ensure the remote control has been programmed to the Smart Button™. Refer to section 2 for how to program a transmitter to the receiver.

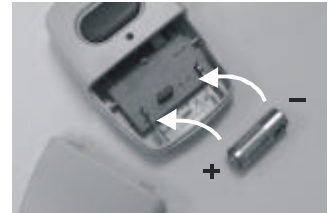
4. REMOVE THE REMOTE CONTROL FROM THE SMART BUTTON™

You can delete the remote control(s) from the Smart Button™, first delete all the remote controls, then learn the ones you would like to keep.

1. Press and hold the learn button for approx 10 seconds on the Smart Button™.
2. The LED will flash rapidly after 10 seconds to indicate all the programmed remote controls have been erased. You may now release the learn button.
3. You have erased all the remote controls in the Smart Button™.

5. BATTERY

12 volt alkaline battery (size 23A) included.



6. ADDITIONAL TRANSMITTER

You can add up to 15 additional transmitters to control the same receiver. Skylink® offers Keychain Transmitters and Keypad Transmitters to work with your receiver. For more information, please visit our website at www.skylinkhome.com or contact us.
