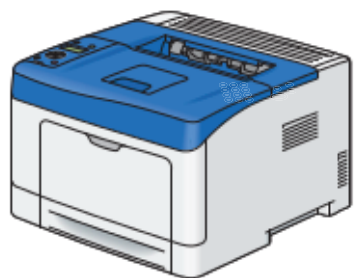


Setting up the DocuPrint P365 d printer on a wireless network with Mac OSX



Before you begin

Ensure your Mac is already setup on your network, and you have **your network name (SSID)**, **type of security encryption** (type of password), and **wireless network password**.

To find the name and type of security encryption on your Mac computer (OS X 10.9):

- Go to System preferences.
- Click Network.
- Select Wifi (on some OS X 10.X versions it is Airport).
- Click Advanced.
- Note your preferred network name and the associated type of security encryption.

1 Install the WiFi Adapter to your Printer

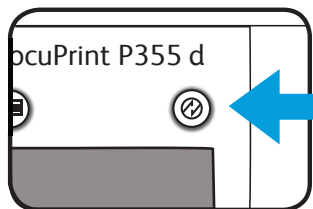
At the back of the printer:

- Switch off the power to the printer. The switch is located on the lower left side of the printer.
- Unpack the Wireless Network Adapter.
- Insert the Wireless Network Adapter into the Wireless Network Adapter Port on the rear left of the printer.

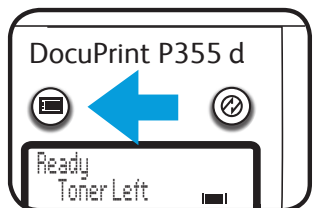


- Switch on the power to the printer.

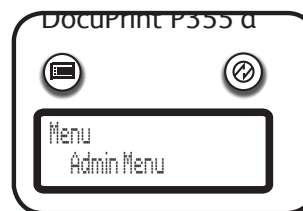
2 Connect the printer to the Network



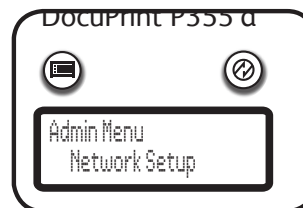
- Press the small green Energy Saver button to wake up the printer



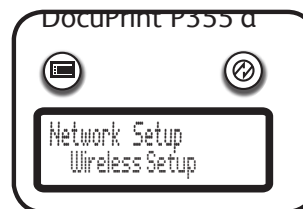
- Press the System button. This is the button to the top left of the LCD screen.



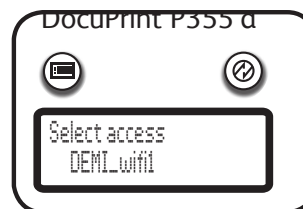
- Scroll to **Admin Menu** and press **OK**.



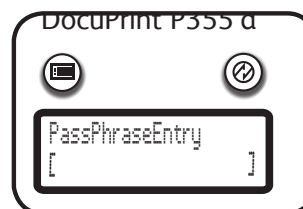
- Scroll to **Network Setup** and press **OK**.



- Scroll to **Wireless Setup** and press **OK**.



- Scroll to the name of your wireless network and then press **OK**.



- Enter the **Wireless Passcode** and then press **OK**.

- At the printer power switch turn off the printer, wait five (5) seconds before turning the printer back on. Wait a few minutes while the printer restarts.

To check that the printer is connected to the wireless network:

- Press the **System** button on the operator panel.
- Scroll to **Admin Menu** and press **OK**.
- Scroll to **Network Menu** and press **OK**.
- Select **Wireless Status** and press **OK**.

If the status is **Good** the printer is successfully connected.

3 Install the drivers on your Mac computer

The following procedure uses Mac OS X 10.9 as an example:

- Run the **PostScript Library CD-ROM** on the Mac OS X.
- Double-click **FXSOPS-PS**.
- Double-click the **English** folder.
- Double-click the **MacOSX10.3.9-10.7** folder.
- Double-click **mac103ps.dmg**
- Double-click **P355 Print Installer**, then click **Continue**.
- Click **Continue**.
- If you agree to the terms and conditions, click **Continue** and then click **Agree**.
- Click **Install**.
- Enter your computer password if requested, and click **Install software**.
- Click **Close**.

4 Add the printer

The following procedure uses Mac OS X 10.9 as an example.

- From the Apple menu, open your **System Preferences**, then click **Printers & Scanners**.
- Click the **+** plus sign and select **Fuji Xerox DocuPrint P355 d**
Wait while the printer is set up and then print a test page
- With the **Fuji Xerox DocuPrint P355 d** selected. Click **Open Print Queue**, then from the **Printer** menu choose **Print Test Page**, when successful a test page will print.
