*If you are connecting the machine via USB:*

- *The interface cable is not a standard accessory. Please purchase an appropriate USB 2.0 interface cable.*
- *Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 interface cable that is no longer than 6 feet long (2 metres).*
- *Your DCP has a USB 2.0 Full-Speed interface. This interface is compatible with USB 2.0 Hi-Speed; however, the maximum data transfer rate will be 12 Mbits/s. The DCP can also be connected to a computer that has a USB 1.1 interface.*

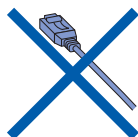

## 1 Removing the Protective Parts

- 1 Remove the protective tape.



**DO NOT connect the USB cable.**  
Connecting the USB cable is done when installing the driver.

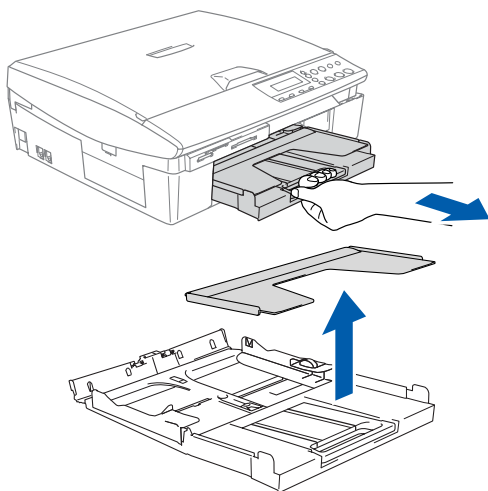


## 2 Loading Paper



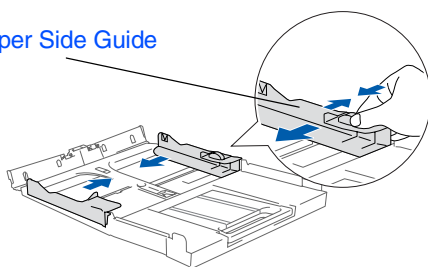
You can load up to 100 sheets of 20 lb paper.  
For more details, see "About paper" in Chapter 1 of the User's Guide.

- 1 Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine and remove the output paper tray.

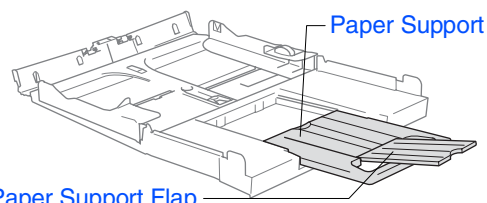


- 2 Press and slide the paper guide to fit the paper width.

Paper Side Guide

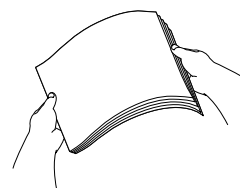


- 3 Pull out the paper support and unfold the paper support flap.

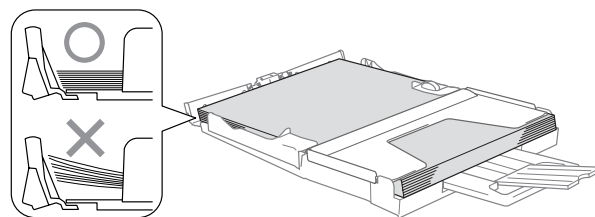
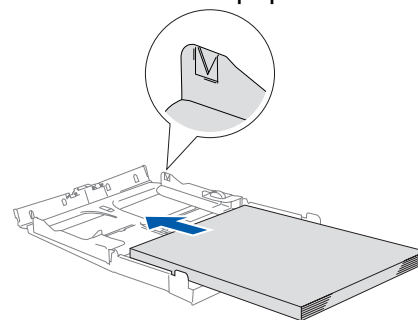


- Use the paper support flap for Letter, Legal and A4 size paper.

- 4 Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and mis-feeds.

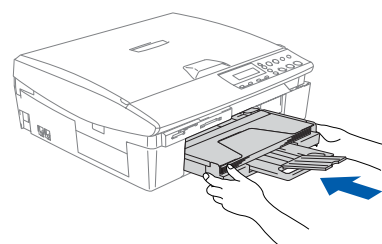


- 5 Gently insert the paper into the paper tray print side down and top edge first. Check that the paper is flat in the tray and below the maximum paper mark.



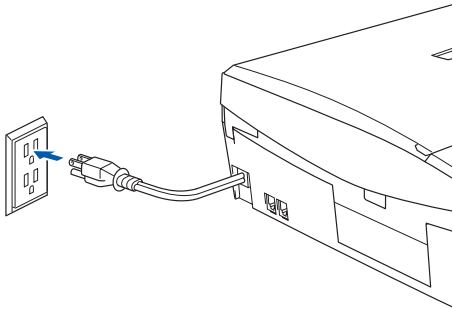
- Make sure the paper side guides touch the sides of the paper.
- Be careful that you do not push the paper in too far; it may lift at the back of the tray and cause paper feed problems.

- 6 Put the output paper tray back on and push the paper tray firmly back into the machine.



### 3 Installing the Power Cord

- 1 Connect the power cord.



 **DO NOT connect the USB cable yet.**

#### **Warning**

The DCP must be connected to a grounded/earthed plug.

### 4 Installing the Ink Cartridges

#### **Warning**

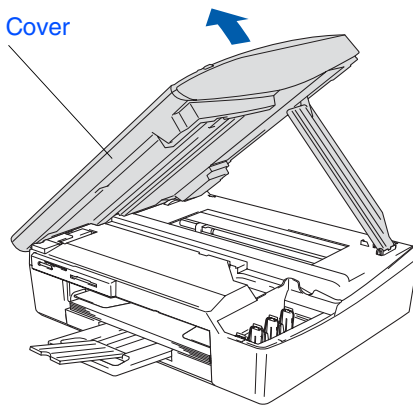
If ink gets in your eyes wash them with water immediately, and if irritation occurs consult a doctor.

- 1 Make sure that the power is turned on. The LCD shows:

- 2 Lift the scanner cover from the right-hand side of the DCP until it locks securely into the open position.

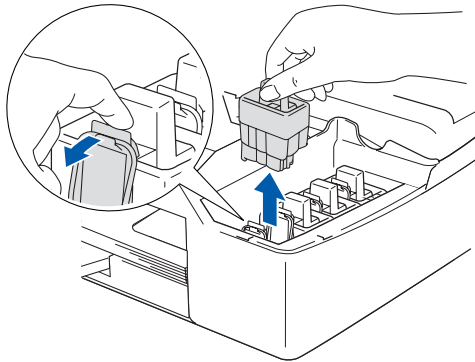

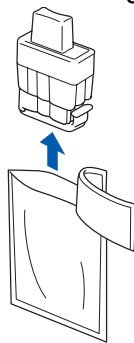

- 3 Remove the protective parts.



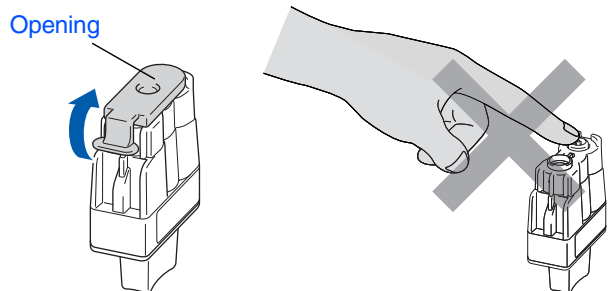
 Do not throw away the protective parts. You will need them when you transport the machine.


- 4 Take out the ink cartridge.



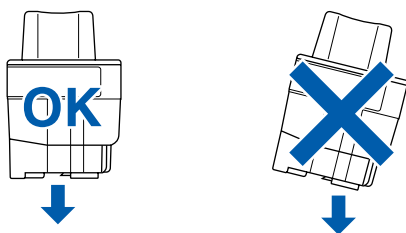
- 5 Carefully remove the bottom cap.

 **DO NOT touch the area shown in the illustration below.**

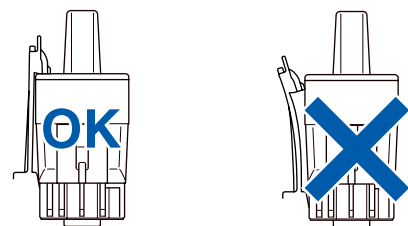
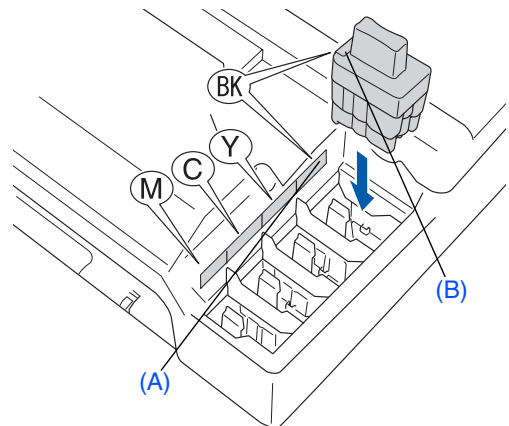


 If the cartridge cover comes off when you open the bag the cartridge will not be damaged.


Keep the ink cartridge in an upright position when you insert it into the slot.

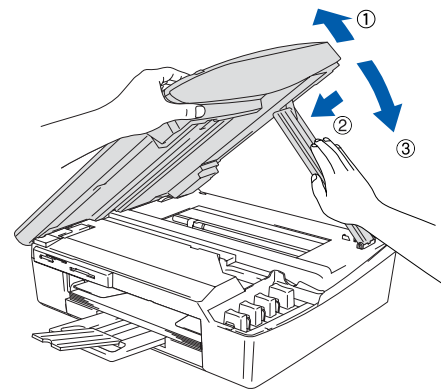


- 6 Press firmly down on the ink cartridge until the hook snaps over it, taking care to match the slot color (A) with the cartridge color (B), as shown in the diagram below.



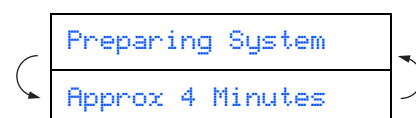
- 7 Lift the scanner cover to release the lock. Gently push the scanner cover support down and close the scanner cover.

 If **Install** shows on the LCD after you install the ink cartridges, check to make sure the ink cartridges are installed correctly.



The machine will clean the ink tube system for use for the first time. This process will occur only once, the first time ink cartridges are installed. The cleaning process will last approximately four minutes.

The LCD shows:







- **DO NOT** remove ink cartridges if you do not need to replace them. If you do so, it may reduce the ink quantity and the machine will not know the quantity of ink left in the cartridge.
- **DO NOT** shake the ink cartridges. If ink stains your body or clothing, wash with soap or detergent immediately.
- **DO NOT** dismantle or tamper with the ink cartridge, this can cause the ink to leak out of the cartridge.
- **Brother strongly recommends that you do not refill the ink cartridges provided with your machine. We also strongly recommend that you continue to use only Genuine Brother Brand replacement ink cartridges. Using or attempting to use potentially incompatible inks and/or cartridges in your machine may cause damage to the machine itself and/or it may result in unsatisfactory print quality. Our warranty coverage does not apply to any problem that was caused by the use of unauthorized third party ink and/or cartridges. To protect your investment and guarantee your print quality please continue to replace consumed ink cartridges with only Genuin Brother Brand Supplies.**
- **DO NOT** insert and remove the cartridges repeatedly. If you do so, the ink may seep out of the cartridge.

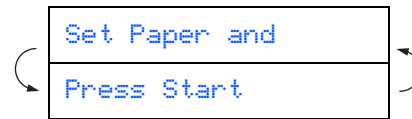


- *If you mix the colors by installing an ink cartridge in the wrong position, you must clean the print head by running several cleaning cycles after correcting the cartridge installation. (See "Cleaning the print head" in chapter 5 Troubleshooting and Routine Maintenance of the User's Guide.)*
- *Once you open an ink cartridge, install it in the machine and use it up within six months of installation. Use unopened ink cartridges by the expiration date written on the cartridge package.*

# Print Quality Check

- 1 After the cleaning cycle is finished, the LCD shows:



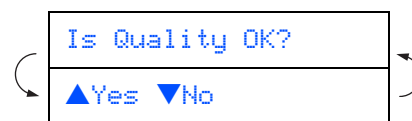
- 2 Make sure the paper is loaded in the paper tray.  
Press **Color Start**.

- 3 The machine starts printing the PRINT QUALITY CHECK SHEET (only during initial ink cartridge installation).



**Avoid touching the printed surface of the paper immediately after printing, the surface may not be completely dry and may stain your fingers.**

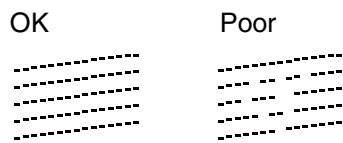
Check the quality of the four color blocks formed by the short lines printed on the sheet.

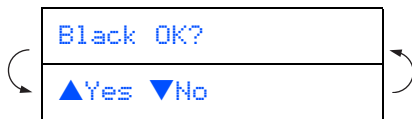

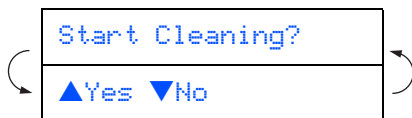
- 5 If all lines are clear and visible, press ▲ to finish the quality check.  
---OR---  
If you can see missing short lines, press ▼ and go to 6.



- 6 The LCD asks you if the print quality is OK for black and color. Press ▲ or ▼ on the control panel.



After making your selection ▲ (Yes) or ▼ (No) for black and color, the LCD shows:



Press ▲ (Yes), the machine will then start cleaning the colors.

After cleaning is finished, press **Color Start**. The machine starts printing the PRINT QUALITY CHECK SHEET again and goes back to step 3.

## 6 Selecting Your Language (Canada only)

- 1 Press **Menu**.
  - 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to select 0. *Initial Setup*. Press **Set**.
  - 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select 0. *Local Language*. Press **Set**.
  - 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select your language (English or French). Press **Set**.

## Setting the Date and Time

Setting the date and time allows the machine to clean the print head regularly and maintain optimum print quality. It also allows the machine to name files created when using the Scan to Card feature.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to select **0.Initial Setup**, and then press **Set**.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select **1.Date/Time**, and then press **Set**.
- 4 Press ▲ repeatedly to enter the last two digits of the year, and then press **Set**.  
  
 (e.g. Enter **0 4** for 2004.)
- 5 Press ▲ repeatedly to enter the two digits for the month, and then press **Set**.  
  
 (e.g. Enter **0 3** for March.)
- 6 Press ▲ repeatedly to enter the two digits for the day, and then press **Set**.  
  
 (e.g. Enter **0 1**.)
- 7 Press ▲ repeatedly to enter the two digits for the hour in 24-hour format, and then press **Set**.  
  
 (e.g. Enter **1 5** for 3:00 P.M.)

- 8 Press ▲ repeatedly to enter the two digits for the minute, and then press **Set**.

(e.g. Enter **1 5, 2 5** for 3:25 P.M.)



You can increase or decrease the number at a stretch by holding down ▲ or ▼.

- 9 Press **Stop/Exit**.



If you want to repeat from step 1, press **Stop/Exit**.



To confirm the current date and time, print out the *User Settings Report*. (See "Printing reports" of Appendix in the User's Guide)

The optional External Wireless Print/Scan Server (NC-2200w) provides wireless network printing and network scanning capabilities.



- Requires USB 2.0 cable (not included).
- Supports Mac OS® X 10.2.4 or greater.
- You can assign the scan key to one networked computer only.

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
